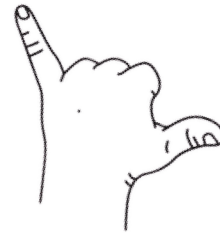

PROVIDING HOPE FOR THOSE FIGHTING CANCER

ABOUT US: UVSC stands for “Us Versus Cancer” and is a Hawaii-based 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that was founded by cancer survivor, Jamil Newirth, and Chris Thibaut, who lost his father to cancer in 1997. Inspired by the community who took it upon themselves to organize events and support Jamil after he was diagnosed with Stage IV brain cancer, UVSC was created with a vision of bringing communities together to support each other in times of greatest need and against all odds – and most importantly, to provide hope so no one has to fight cancer alone.

OUR IMPACT: Since 2017, UVSC’s Financial Assistance Program has served 23 cancer fighters and their family members (nearly 80 individuals total) and provided over \$110,000 in aid to help cover out-of-pocket treatment-related expenses and basic needs. UVSC assists with a broad range of expenses such as: travel (air, lodging, ground transport) related to treatment, medical co-pays, utility bills, rental/mortgage assistance, food, medical devices, and much more. UVSC also maintains a special fund to assist cancer fighters that are Maui Wildfire victims, as well.
